Lesson 2 – Results of Wisdom (Ch. 1-4)

"Blessed is the one who finds wisdom, and the one who gets understanding, for the gain from her is better than gain from silver and her profit better than gold. She is more precious than jewels, and nothing you desire can compare with her. Long life is in her right hand; in her left hand are riches and honor. Her ways are ways of pleasantness, and all her paths are peace. She is a tree of life to those who lay hold of her; those who hold her fast are called blessed." (3:13-18)

Textual/Factual Questions

- 1. What can be the value of a father's and mother's instruction to their child? (1:8-9)
- 2. Read 1:20-33. What is Wisdom offering to those who hear? (v. 23) What will happen to those who listen? What about those who refuse to listen?
- 3. Who does the Lord reprove? (3:11-12)
- 4. How and why do we need to guard our heart? (4:23)

Thought Questions

- 5. Read 2:1-22. List all the different benefits of seeking wisdom described in this chapter and try to summarize the emphasis.
- 6. Chapter 3:5 is a familiar verse to many. What lessons can we take from the rest of the chapter about what it means to trust in the Lord?
- 7. Read 4:26-27. How does the metaphor of walking on a path help us to be upright and avoid evil?

Application

- Proverbs places the value and preciousness of wisdom above all else. Do I place it above all else and seek after it as such? If not, re-commit to a pursuit of the Lord's wisdom and the blessings therein.
