- 1. Who does Israel claim to know? (vs. 2)
- 2. In reality, what did they actually know about and where did this come from? (vs. 5-6)
- 3. What had Israel sown and what had they reaped? (vs. 7) What does this mean?
- 4. What had God done to allow them to actually know Him? (vs. 12)
- 5. Application For Us: What false religious concepts or practices today can keep us from actually knowing our True God & Creator?

"They Will Bear No Fruit" vs. 16 (Hosea 9:1-11)

- 6. What two nations are mentioned to describe what will happen to Israel? (vs. 3) Historically, Egypt represented what condition for God's people? (Deut. 28:68)
- 7. Why had the "days of punishment" come? (vs. 7)
- 8. Things are so bad in Israel that their wickedness is described in vs 9 as "deep in depravity" like the "days of Gibeah." Review Judges 19:16-30 to see how terrible things had become.
- 9. In verse 10-17 Hosea compares Israel to both the fruit of the field and the fruit of the family (children). According to verse 17 why will their fruitfulness fail?
- 10. Application For Us: According to Jesus in John 15:1-11 what is essential to our fruitfulness? What is the consequence of being unfruitful?

- 11. When Israel was given economic prosperity, how did they use it? (vs. 1)
- 12. How do Jesus and John use the words of Hosea 10:8? (Luke 23:30, Revelation 6:16, 9:6)
- 13. What metaphor does Hosea use for the people's choices in 10:11-13?
- 14. Application For Us: According to Galatians 6:7-10, what should we be sowing?
